

## Which Jobs for Which Kids?

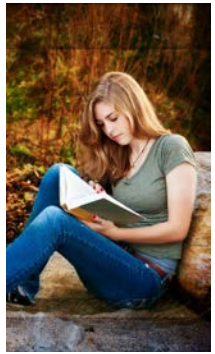
